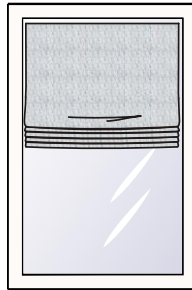


Measuring for a Roman Shade

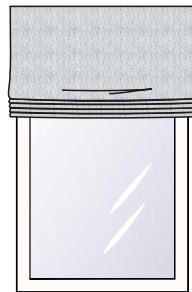
Inside Mount Roman Shade:

1. Take 3 inside frame to frame width measurements: top, middle and bottom of window. Record narrowest width below
 - a. Narrowest width: _____
 - b. Deduct 3/8" for shade finished width
2. Take 1 inside frame to frame length measurement
 - a. Inside Length:



Outside Mount Roman Shade:

1. Measure outside width of window frame to frame:
 - a. Outside width _____
 - b. Add 1" for Shade Finished width
2. Measure outside length frame to frame:
 - a. Outside Length _____
 - b. To clear window when up add a minimum of 6"
 - c. Finished length (with clearance)



Highlighted dimensions will be the finished shade dimensions you give to your workroom for quoting or ordering purposes. Remember to note whether your shade is an inside or outside mount and whether you have taken a deduction.
